

WORK NOTIFICATION – START OF WORK

28 February 2020

The urban renewal of Honeysuckle is a signature project for Hunter and Central Coast Development Corporation (HCCDC). Honeysuckle is changing and with new open space areas alongside residential, commercial and entertainment precincts, it is essential there is easy access for cars, bikes and pedestrians along the length of Honeysuckle Drive.

Robson Civil Projects is working on behalf of HCCDC to realign Honeysuckle Drive between Hannell Street and Steel Street to improve traffic flow through the area.

Work includes:

- realigning approximately 420 metres of Honeysuckle Drive between Hannell Street to Steel Street
- shared pathways on both sides of Honeysuckle Drive tying into the existing footpaths at the western and eastern extents
- bike and parking lanes along some sections of the road
- kerb and guttering for the length of the new road, signs, line marking, landscaping and environmental protection works

How will this affect you?

Construction work will be occurring near your address. Traffic movements and car parking in the precinct will be maintained throughout construction but there will be diversions and changes to parking arrangements. Construction is expected take 10 to 12 months to complete, however the timing may change slightly depending upon weather and operational requirements.

Work Hours

Most activity will be carried out from 7am until 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturday from 8am to 3pm, weather permitting. If we need to work outside these times, we will let you know.

Traffic and parking changes

A temporary road will be constructed through Throsby Temporary Car Park to divert traffic from Honeysuckle Drive.

- The diversion will be in place from Thursday 26 March 2020 until project completion
- Directional signage and traffic management will be in place during this diversion
- Additional detail on changes to traffic conditions will be provided soon

Upcoming Work

Work will commence Monday 2 March 2020. Initial work will include:

- Utilities investigations
- Work area establishment which will involve changing the configuration of Throsby Temporary Car Park
- Demolition of kerb and guttering and creation of new car park entrance
- Installation of temporary fencing around the work site
- Tree removal to enable road re-alignment
- Line marking works

This work will involve:

- Excavation and earthworks
- Vehicle movements including trucks and utility vehicles, and asphalt and cement trucks.
- Cement cutting, rock breaking, drilling and use of hand tools
- Removal and replacement of road surface

Upcoming Night Work

Night work will occur between 7pm Wednesday 11 March and 5am Thursday 12 March 2020 to install temporary fencing at the Throsby Temporary Car Park and works for the temporary diversion.

This work will involve:

- Excavation works and pavement placement
- Limited demolition works
- Installation of fencing
- Vehicle movements including trucks and utility vehicles
- Use of hand tools, generators and site lighting
