

Notification: Honeysuckle Park Construction

NOTICE OF EXTENSION: Temporary Footpath Closure for Reconstruction of Pavement, and Fire Escape Egress

Due to recent bad weather, works involving the reconstruction of pavement will extend until project shut down (last day of work for the year is 23^{rd} December 2020). During this time, the footpath running along the back of the Lume Apartments (21, 23, and 25 Honeysuckle Drive) will remain closed. The footpath will be reopened for Christmas Eve.

Fire escape egress shall be provided while the footpath remains closed. The boundary of the egress will be indicated using bunting and star pickets. Escape will be through the one-way gates shown in blue in the diagram below.



Fire access and direction signage shall be posted in the area during the notification period.

Residents should be aware that this access is for emergency use only, and that any unauthorised access to the site is prohibited. Penalties may apply to persons accessing the site without authority.
