HONEYSUCKLE DRIVE REALIGNMENT

Robson Civil Projects is working on behalf of HCCDC to realign Honeysuckle Drive between Hannell Street and Steel Street.

TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS WILL BE IN PLACE

On Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 December, westbound traffic on Honeysuckle Drive will be diverted for work to be completed on the westbound lane.

On Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 December, eastbound traffic on Honeysuckle Drive will be diverted for work to be completed on the eastbound lane.

If work is unable to be completed during these times, the work will take place on the next available weekend.

Work will include:

- Temporary movement of entry to Throsby Car Park approximately 30 metres east of its current location.
- Earthworks to remove road surface near Cottage Creek Bridge
- Kerbing, asphalting, line marking, concreting, and landscaping works.

Weekend Traffic Changes

Traffic will be diverted via Steel Street and Hunter Street during these works and directional signage and traffic control will be in place. Access to Throsby Car Park will be maintained during these works.

Pedestrian Changes

The new footpath on the south side of Honeysuckle Drive will be open to pedestrians. Pedestrians on the north side of Honeysuckle Drive will use the existing footpath and pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Honeysuckle and Steel Streets.

A temporary footpath will be in place for pedestrians travelling West on Honeysuckle Drive to provide access to Hannell Street.

NEW HONEYSUCKLE DRIVE ROAD ALIGNMENT IN PLACE

The new Honeysuckle Drive road alignment is expected to be in place from **Wednesday 16 December.** The following changes will be in place once this Westbound land is opened. These include:

Westbound traffic is expected to travel on the new Honeysuckle Drive road alignment over the new Cottage Creek Bridge followed by the eastbound lane during the weekend of 19 and 20 December. Following these changes, entrance to the Throsby Car Park will be accessible via the eastbound lane only.

Work will include:

- Works to final configuration of car park
- Continued demolition of Cottage Creek over slab
- Movement of car park entrance to permanent location
- Kerbing, asphalting, line marking, concreting, and landscaping works.

Traffic Changes

Works will be managed under traffic control at either end of the work zone.

A new section of road adjacent to Station Street will operate in a one-way configuration from 16 December 2020.

Completion of Road Realignment Works

Once both lanes of traffic have access to the new Cottage Creek Bridge, finishing works including kerbs and gutters, landscaping, line marking, and lighting installation will be completed in January 2021.

What to expect during construction

There may be some noise associated with this work. We apologise for the inconvenience and will aim to minimise the impact of our work by:

- > Turning off equipment when not in use
- > Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery (including delivery vehicles)
- > Positioning noisy equipment as far away as possible from residents and businesses.
