

Construction of Parklands Road Upgrade

Notification – September 2022

Bolte Civil, on behalf of Hunter and Central Coast Development Corporation, are commencing works on the upgrade of Parklands Road, and its adjacent service infrastructure in September 2022. The Project spans the full length of Parklands Road, including the area in front of Mt Penang Gardens, and involves the reconstruction of Parklands Road, upgrades to Sewer, Water and Electrical networks, and other general safety improvements. The work will be carried out in Stages commencing this September.

UPCOMING WORK

Whilst preparatory works are occurring throughout September, roadworks on Parklands Road are commencing on the 26th September and will involve some traffic restrictions and flow changes. Please obey all directional and roadworks signs when travelling through the Mt Penang Gardens area. The first stage of works is from the roundabout at Festival Drive, to the Café at Carinya St. Please note that the Waterfall café will continue to operate as normal during this stage.

Additionally, some works will occur offline, in a new section of Parklands Road, which will have minimal impact on traffic flows. This section adjoins the new works at Baxter Track.
